General Principles

- simplification is in the interest of all stakeholders
- it is necessary to provide stability and legal certainty
- there is also a need for trust-based and risktolerant approaches without sacrificing procedural rigour.





Four Main Points Concerning the Draft Report

- Administrative and financial simplification;
- Improvement of quality, accessibility and transparency;
- Enhanced synergy between programmes and instruments;
